The Live a Full Life Award will be awarded to a senior at both Smithtown High School East and West senior. This award will provide \$1,000 to a student who has exhibited their commitment to living life to the fullest while also having a positive impact on those around them. For this award, a “full life” is defined as having a positive influence on others and bringing people together in support of others, all while exhibiting passion, joy and exuberance for the experiences shared with others. Preference will be given to students who have overcome a serious obstacle in life. Future college attendance is not a requirement.

Check list: Be sure that all of the following items have been complete. Any missing information can disqualify the applicant.

- Application
- GPA of 2.75 or better
- High school transcript
- Two Letters of Recommendation (not a requirement but will be considered)
- Personal essay that provides examples of how the student is living a full life, the experiences and/or influences that led them to act in that manner, and the ways in which they intend to continue to do so into their adult lives.
